- 1. Entries must reach the Superintendent, Jack Bradshaw, 320 Maple Avenue, Torrance, CA 90503, by Noon, Wednesday December 11, 2024 PST. Fees should accompany entries. This club and/or its superintendent assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its superintendents assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
- 2. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and declined credit card. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check or declined credit card MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
- 3. Exhibitors' Identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the superintendent. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held at the Superintendent's Office. PLEASE BRING YOUR IDENTIFICATION TICKETS TO THE SHOW.
- 4. During the hours of judging owners or their handlers are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, In order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- 5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the superintendent's office advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
- 6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rulebooks are available online at www.akc.org
- 7. The club, its superintendents or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- 8. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$4.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.
- 9. Declination of Entries. The Kennel Club of Palm Springs may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.

- 12. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the Closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship.
- 13. No practicing allowed in conformation rings at any time. A warm-up ring will be provided for Obedience and Rally exhibitors near the Obedience rings.
- 14. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- 15. Individual canopies/pop-ups may not block the entrance or entrances to tented grooming areas.
- 16. No flexi-leads may be used on the show grounds. No unattended soft side crates allowed on grounds.
- 17. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

- **Novice Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **Novice Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **Novice Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **Open Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **Open Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **Open Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.
- Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show,or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.
- Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.
- Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, go online at www.akc.org.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.
• If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.

- o If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- o If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- $_{\odot}$ If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- o If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- o If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- o No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring. The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.
- *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years
- **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS. .AKC Revised 5/11/18

RAMP - At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever, American Water Spaniel, Boykin Spaniels, English Springer Spaniel, Field Spaniel, Welsh Springer Spaniel, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeen, Whippet, German Pinscher, Standard Schnauzer, American Staffordshire Terrier, Irish Terrier, Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, Finnish Spitz, Australian Cattle Dogs, Entlebucher Mountain Dog, Finnish Lapphund, Icelandic Sheepdog, Mudi, Norwegian Buhund, Polish Lowland Sheepdog, Puli, Spanish Water Dog, Norrbottenspet.

The following breeds may be judged on the ground, table or ramp: Miniature Bull Terrier.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniel, Sussex Spaniel, Basset Hound, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terrier, Bulldog, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chow, Keeshond.

Junior showmanship judges should follow the above.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.) 4/3/24

DOG SHOW PARKING

Day-of-Show Parking /Official Parking: Monrow Ave to Ave 51, and follow the signs to designated areas.

- 1. Day-of-show parking for cars and small vans may be on grass. No setups allowed in day-of-show parking area.
- 2. All parking on streets adjacent to the show site will be subject to local regulations and restrictions.
- 3. No un-entered dogs will be allowed on the show grounds.
- 4. Unloading zones will be indicated; cars may not be left unattended. Cars are not to be left in unloading zone for more than 15 minutes. Please unload and move your vehicle from the loading zone to the general parking area, as directed, and return to your dog(s) and equipment.
- 5., Security Officer will be on duty Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights and on the days of the shows, but neither KCPS nor Empire Polo Club/ Goldenvoice can be responsible for any personal property left unattended under grooming tents.
- 6. No exercise pens/setups will be allowed within 20 feet of any ring, in the center aisles, or in any other area posted "No Setups".
- 7. Dogs/crates are allowed under main tents <u>ONLY</u> during judging for that breed and must be removed 15 min after judging of that breed— NO EXCEPTIONS unattended dogs/crates will be removed by KCPS. One crate per dog will be permitted in the center aisle, and it must be removed 15 min. after Breed judging.
- 8. No crates are to be left overnight. NO UNATTENDED SOFT CRATES ARE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- 9. Grounds will not be available for setups until 3 PM Wednesday. This time may be modified at the discretion of the Show Committee. There may be some distance from setup area to your ring(s). Please allow enough time to get to your ring on time.
- 10. Events or circumstances not covered in these operating policies and procedures may be subject to special consideration and stipulations, as deemed appropriate by Empire Polo Club management.
- 11. There will be a limited number of chairs available at ringside. Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to bring their own chairs.
- 12 Areas that are not marked RESERVED or marked "NO SET-UPS" are for "No cost" grooming. **No set-ups are allowed in aisles or within 20 ft. of a ring.** Exhibitors are encouraged to bring their own shade for these areas. Please make the best possible use of those areas and be considerate of others.
- 13. This is a No Smoking and Non Vaping venue
- 14 NO Flexi Leads and baby strollers allowed under any tents during show hours.
- 15. All Grooming is to be done in Provided Areas away from any ring.
- 16. No Motorhomes, Oversized vehicles (takes more than 1 parking space) or trailers in the Day of Show Parking

DAY OF SHOW PARKING INFORMATION

(There will be unloading areas at each end of the show grounds.)

Some parking areas may be some distance from your ring(s). Unloading areas are provided on the West side of the showgrounds. After unloading and when parked in the DAY OF SHOW parking areas, primarily for people and are very limited in the transporting of dogs or equipment. Therefore, if you will need the shuttle services, be sure to unload all dogs and equipment from the Unloading Areas to your set-up space.

<u>Please follow the instructions of parking attendants.</u> The time limit in the unloading/loading areas is 15 mins. With no exceptions. Day-of-Show parking will be **\$20.00** per parking space. NO Vehicles requiring more than one space (motor homes, Oversized vehicles or trailers etc.) allowed in the Day-of-Show or Overflow parking lot.. No overnight parking will be allowed in the Day of Show parking lots. Anyone not following KCPS rules risks having his/her vehicle towed at owners' expense.

Abusive Behavior or aggressive behavior will not be tolerated.

RESERVED GROOMING TENTS

Due to fire, health, and safety concerns from the Riverside County Fire Marshall's Office, NO PERSONAL GENERATORS WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS (except for use by the KCPS & contracted KCPS entities necessary for operation of the shows, and built-in RV units in the Overnight RV Parking Area.)

ALL Tented Reserved Grooming Spaces will have power and lights. Power to Grooming Tents will be available Thursday through Sunday starting at 6AM and will be turned off one hour after the last BIS each day.

- b. All RV Parking Group members must be fully paid before the payment submittal deadline.

- 10. All RV parking spaces are 22' wide by 40' long. Box Van spaces are 22' x35'. Motor homes over 40' long will be parked in designated rows.
- 11. No foul or abusive language will be tolerated; anyone not following parking rules will be asked to leave, and no refunds will be given.
- 12. **Power-Driven** (gasoline or electric, including electric scooters) **convenience vehicles are forbidden on the showgrounds (i.e., the grass areas).** Power-Driven mobility vehicles that are required for handicap mobility are allowed as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act ("ADA").

the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and

the adult.

A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.

All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.

A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to

maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.

Dogs that are allowed: AKC fully recognized, Miscellaneous Class breeds, PAL listings, FSS

breeds, and All-American

A release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Pee Wee Release of Liability will

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized
- Breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*
